

# Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Projects

## Federal Economic Stimulus Funding

### State Energy Program

\$ Stimulus Bill – \$3,100,000,000

\$ NYS Share – \$126,000,000

### Status

- Issuance of Program Guidance by DOE is pending; NYSERDA to submit Plan to DOE within 30 days of issuance of Guidance
- NYSERDA will solicit applications for Projects following DOE approval (expected by May, 2009)

### Potential Uses

- Energy efficiency (EE) and renewable energy capital projects
- Building and facility energy audits
- EE in residential housing
- Transportation EE and alternative fuels

### Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants

\$ Stimulus Bill – \$ 400,000,000 for competitive grants; \$2,800,000,000 by formula as specified below:

- 68% to “large” cities (>35,000) and “large” counties (>200,000) New York share TBD
- 16.8% (\$18,000,000) to NYSERDA for small municipalities
- 11.2% (\$13,200,000) to NYSERDA for the State Energy Program

### Status

- Issuance of Program Guidance by DOE is pending
- Large cities and counties will apply directly to DOE for grants
- NYSERDA will receive funds from DOE and issue application process for small municipality project funding
- Timeframe to be determined

### Potential Uses

- Building energy audits
- Financial incentives for EE retrofits
- Transportation EE programs
- Building code services
- Energy distribution technologies
- Material conservation programs
- Technologies to reduce or capture greenhouse gases from landfills
- Replacement of traffic signals and street lighting with EE technologies
- On-site renewable energy technology that generates electricity for government buildings

### Alternative Fueled Vehicles Pilot Grants

\$ Stimulus Bill – \$300,000,000  
Competitive grants

### Status

- DOE has issued Funding Opportunity Notice; proposals due on May 29, 2009
- NYSERDA to coordinate responses

### Potential Uses

- Alternative fueled vehicles, hybrid vehicles, or fuel cell vehicles
- Fueling infrastructure
- Operation and maintenance

### Transportation Electrification

\$ Stimulus Bill – \$400,000,000  
Competitive grants

### Status

- Pending issuance of Funding Opportunity Notice by DOE

### Potential Uses

- Projects that encourage the use of plug-in electric drive vehicles
- Truck-stop electrification, electric truck refrigeration, electric rail
